Call for Papers

The year of 2018 marks the 40th anniversary of China's reform and opening-up. During the BRICS Xiamen Summit on September 2017, President Xi Jinping said China would solemnly commemorate the 40th anniversary of China's reform and opening-up. On October 18th, 2017, Comrade Xi Jinping reemphasized China's adherence to the path of peaceful development and the efforts on building a community of a shared future for mankind. How to draw lessons and experience from the 40-year reform and opening-up as well as the development of the Belt and Road while reaching consensus for the establishment of a community of a shared future for mankind and the win-win cooperation for emerging economies, are worthy of further study and discussion.

On the occasion of the 6th anniversary of Emerging Economies Forum, in order to further integrate government, enterprises, academia, societies and media, and to discuss the current state and prospects of Emerging Economies, China Society of Emerging Economies and Guangdong Emerging Economies Society made a decision to jointly hold *China Society of Emerging Economics Annual Conference 2018& Emerging Economies Forum 2018* based on the topic ***China's 40-year Reform and Opening-up and a Community of Shared Future for Mankind*** in Guangdong University of Technology(Guangzhou Higher Education Mega Center Campus)

from 16th to 18th Nov. 2018(Fri.to Sun.). In order to enrich the forum and have better academic exchanges, **Calling for Papers** home and abroad are warmly welcome. Following are notices.

I. Topics Range

The paper is based on the theme of the forum and topics of 4 sub-forums. The range includes but is not limited to:

Theme: ***China's 40-year Reform and Opening-up and a Community of Shared Future for Mankind***

Topic 1: 40 Years of China's Economic Reform (The summary of Chinese Model (Socialism with Chinese characteristics), the comparison between Chinese Model and other development models and the lessons and enlightenment for emerging economies to enrich the *reform theories*, etc.);

Topic 2: 40 Years of China's Opening-up (The practice and experience of China's opening-up, the comparison between China and other emerging economies on opening-up and China's contribution to international political economics on its opening-up, etc.)

Topic 3: The Construction of a New Mechanism for Opening-up in all respects(Global governance, the development of “the Belt and Road” , Free Trade Zones and Free Trade Ports and the opening-up of Guangdong-Hongkong-Macau Greater Bay Area as well as other regions, etc.);

Topic 4: A Community of Shared Future for Mankind(The synergy and cooperation of emerging economies on regional development strategies, the imbalance and inadequacy on economic development, the path of peaceful development, the new models of international relations, the global partnership as well as the South-South and BRICS co-operations, etc.)

II Requirements

1. Self-determine concrete title according to the topics mentioned above.
2. Submitted papers are supposed to be original and unpublished.
3. Language: Scholars whose mother tongue is Chinese should write in Chinese, while those whose mother tongue is not, should use English unanimously.
4. Format & Requirements: Chinese papers can refer to *World Economy* or *World Economics and Politics*, while English ones can refer to *China and World Economy*. The article length should be around 8000- 10000 words. Paper Format as follows:

(1) Title

(2) Name of the author

(3) Unit+ Province + City + Postcode

(4) Abstract in English (within 1,000 words)

(5) Keywords in English

- (6) Text
- (7) References
- (8) Title in Chinese
- (9) Name of Chinese author (in Chinese)
- (10) Unit + Province + City + Postcode (in Chinese)
- (11) Abstract in Chinese
- (12) Keywords in Chinese

5. Time: From March 12nd to August 20th in 2018. Please send electronic version of completed papers to the email, geescn@126.com, with the format, *EEF2018+workplace+author+topic* in the title of e-mail. And *the author's information should be written solely on the first page.*

6. Statement:

(1) Your paper will be approved by *the Chinese academic journals (CD version) electronic magazine* in *CNKI* and its series of database products in a digital way to copy, compilation, distribution, information network spread. The copyright royalties of the *CNKI* are paid together with the royalties. The author's submission to the PROCEEDINGS is deemed to have agreed to the above statement.

(2) The PROCEEDINGS do not charge any layout fees and review fees, nor commission any organization draft and reviewers. If any organization and individual in any name to the author to charge the above fees, please tell the editorial department of the PROCEEDINGS, not deceived.

III Awards

The assessment committee will conduct anonymous assessment of all submitted papers and select 14 ones which will be awarded 1st, 2nd, 3rd prize and couples of ones awarded graduate excellent paper award according to the principle of fair, equitable, quality first, merit-based. Excellent papers will be given priority to *China and World Economy, World Economy, World Economics and Politics, International Economic Review* to enter the review process. Award winning will be invited to give

a speech and paid.
